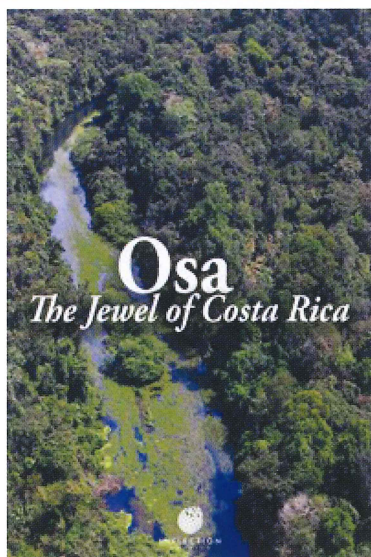

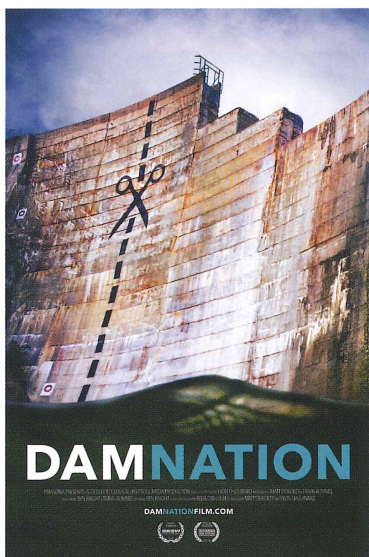
The films remind us that each of us have the power to make changes that we want to see in the world.

Osa: The Jewel of Costa Rica is a sustainable practices success story - where individuals and groups are making a positive difference in caring and healing one of the most bio-diverse tropical rain forests in the world. (51 mins.)



DamNation is a powerful film odyssey across America exploring the sea change in its national attitude from pride in big dams to the growing awareness that its own future is bound to the life and health of its rivers. (87 mins.)



Power to the People introduces the «energy positive» island Samsø, Denmark, and other endeavors in Denmark and the Netherlands to transform the energy industry and local economy. (49 mins.)
